Chaman Bhartiya School will open on August 3. With the lockdown of schools and the continuous rise of COVID-19 cases, we expect only to be allowed to open the school for online learning.

The ban on online learning has been removed. We expect new guidelines from the government regarding online learning and will, of course, follow these.

In our online learning concept, we will have a blend of online activities and other activities in between.
